General Principles

Bufab is committed to protect the environment by preventing pollution, reducing and preventing adverse impacts of resource consumption and waste production in our operations and value chain. This includes optimizing our energy consumption and reduce our environmental influence in terms of waste and direct greenhouse gases, for example by using and promoting environmentally friendly technologies.

Demonstrate:

- How your company by 2031, shall reduce its scope 3 carbon emission intensity with 55%, calculated from base line year 2021.
- How your company achieve 0% of waste to landfill by 2030, with a material recovery rate of > 90%.
- How your company reduce total operational waste by 20% by 2030.
- How your company achieve a material recyclability rate of > 90 % by 2030.
- How your company has taken into account legal and environmental implications before implementing significant operational/business changes or making new acquisitions.
- How your company strive to increase your material efficiency through circular initiatives.
- How your company fulfil environmental rules and legislation where you operate.
- How your company comply with chemical compliance regulations e.g., REACH legislation and the RoHS Directive.
- How the company is assessing exposure to, and mitigating, local risks such as operations in High Conservation Value Area or local Water Risks.
- How your company act transparent and report on material environmental impacts
- How the company is collecting and assuring environmental data requested for the Bufab Group sustainability report.
- How your company ensure that you provide all employees with the tools, information, and opportunities to support our shared commitments and targets as stated in this environmental policy.
- How your company Incorporate ISO 14001 guidelines in our Bufab Best Practice. Creating a continuous improvement cycle for our environmental performance.
